A reminder to all players to check your score card—is your handicap there, correct, signed, and handed in....you wouldn't want to be disqualified.....can happen.....

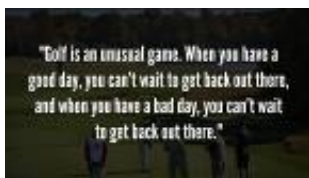
