Know Your Rules—Ball Stuck Up A Tree

There are 3 options—play the ball as it lies (brave move), declare the ball unplayable or proceed under the lost ball ruling.

Unplayable ball—firstly you must be able to identify your ball. Take a one stroke penalty, drop within 2 club lengths from the ground spot directly under the ball.

Lost ball—stroke & distance. One stroke penalty & replay shot from position of previous stroke.
